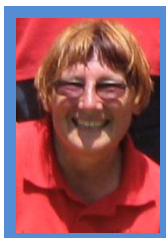

DOG TRAINING
STILL
ON



We have had a very wet start to our winter training but there are still things you can do inside at home to train your dog.

1. Do a couple of exercises before you put your dogs bowl down e.g. sit drop, stand, twist and wait. His dinner will be his fantastic reward.
2. Call your dog down the hallway for a recall and reward when he comes- remember to pay more for a fast recall than a slow one and you need to be very enthusiastic.
3. Take your dog outside to pee on lead and when he starts make a sound (I usually say psss.-,psss) – that way in the future you should be able to get your dog to piddle on command.
4. Train the 'go to mat' exercise inside. To make it more fun, have a couple of mats on the ground and when he goes to each one, reward on the mat.
5. Teach your dog other tricks while you are sitting on the lounge- e.g. give me your paw, beg, four paws on ground(if your dog jumps up on you).

Anything you can teach your dog, teaches him to think and makes future training so much easier

Remember to click the behaviour and then pay the reward.

I hope that the weather will be better during the next month but bring you gummies as the ground at the Showground will still be wet.

Strangest place you have ever had a nap

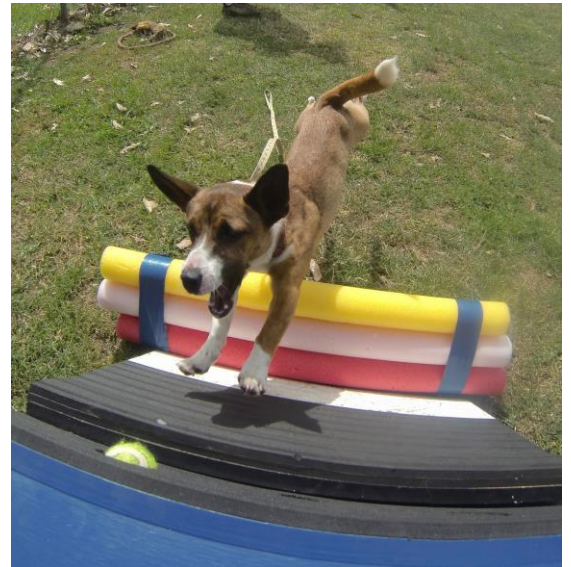
Inside my owner's jacket with the zip up.
